

**TOWN OF PHELPS
ORDINANCE NO. 2011 – 3**

**PROHIBITING FIREARMS IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS, PUBLIC GROUNDS AND
PUBLIC EVENTS**

The Town Board of the Town of Phelps do ordain as follows:

The possession of weapons concealed or otherwise, is prohibited in all buildings owned or occupied by the Town of Phelps including, but not limited to, the following:

1. Town Hall
2. Fire Station
3. All Highway Department Buildings;
4. Library
5. Chamber of Commerce
6. Museum
7. Wavering Park and Soccer Pavillion
8. Town Beach and Town Dock Facility

Signs shall be placed at the entries to such buildings notifying the public of this prohibition.

- (a) The possession of weapons concealed or otherwise, is prohibited at any special event, as that term is defined in sec. 943.13 (1m) (c) 3. Wis. Stats. Signs shall be placed at the entries to such special events notifying the public of this prohibition.
- (b) Exemption: Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to apply to prohibit a peace officer, policeman, armed forces or military personnel armed in the line of duty to possess a firearm in any public building.
- (c) Penalty: Any person who violates this subsection shall, upon conviction, be subject to the following fines in any one year: 1st offense - \$100; 2nd offense - \$200; 3rd offense - \$300.
- (d) The Town Foreman shall cause signs to be erected at all entrances to all buildings owned, occupied or under the control of the Town of Phelps providing notice that no person is to enter or remain in any such building while carrying a firearm. Such signs shall be five inches by seven inches or larger.
- (e) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to authorize the carrying of any firearm or dangerous weapon contrary to Wis. Stats. Section 941.23 or 941.235.
- (f) This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

(g) Approved and adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Phelps on this 10th day of October, 2011.
